

Scope. - By limiting the illustrations in this volume to teaching in elementary schools it has been possible to make the discussion quite concrete. While the general principles presented apply equally well to high schools, teachers in the latter will find the author's Methods of Teaching in High Schools (Ginn and Company, 1915) and his Exercises for Methods of Teaching in High Schools...
